



TYPES OF SUBSTANCES AND IMPACT OF ITS USES

By Sinu Jesin Timothy

Commonly referred as drugs- modifies perception, mood cognition or motor function.

Legal drugs alcohol and tobacco.

ILLEGAL DRUGS

- Depressants
- Canna
- Stimulant
- Opioids
- Hallucinogens



ALCOHOL

- 16 crore use of alcohol in India. (demographic of alcohol use and it acute effect was shown)
- Slurred speech nausea, emotional instability, loss of coordination, visual distortions, impaired memory, sexual dysfunction, loss of consciousness/ increased risk of injuries, violence
- Long term
- Severest form delirium tremens (DTs)

TOBACCO

- Use of tobacco such as cigars or chewing and snuffs.
- Global survey of tobacco uses 2016-27 42 %
- Acute effects feeling relief withdrawal symptoms anxiety, sleep disturbances and depression and affects heart disease, lung cancer

CANNABIS

- Preparation from cannabis sativa plant.
- How is it used such as bhang, ganja, hashish
- Its effects: reduces sleep

OPIODS

- How it is used, prescribed however abused as
- Heroine, brown sugar,
- Prescription drugs tramadol, trapendol
- Used as smoke or injected in the body
- Immediate impact impaired coordination, euphoria, dizziness

SEDATIVE AND HYPNOTICS

- Used for sleeplessness or relieving anxiety.

 - 9. Enabling
 - 10. Denial.
 - Then, the resource person was shared his knowledge about the concept of Epidemiology.

- He explained about "what is Comorbidity" and it's meaning. In the concept of comorbidity, he explained about what causes for the Depression and suicide?
- Further, he explained the term of what is substance use disorder DSM-5(Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorder), ICD-10(International Classification of Diseases) and ICD-11(International Classification of Diseases).
- Finally, he concluded by explaining about what is Alcohol dependence.

After his explanation about the presentation about the signs and symptoms, he called all the participants to clarify the doubts if they have. Students came forward to ask and clarify the doubts to the Resource person.

SESSION - II

"LIFE SKILL EDUCATION"

After finished of 1st session of second day workshop, the second session was followed by **Mr Madhu A S.** The second session was started at 11:20am.

- The second session topic was "Life Skill Education".
- ➤ He started his session by asking question to all the participants with the question of What is Life Skill?
- ➤ The participants came forward to answer for resource person's question, and the resource person was happy to receive the answer from the participants.

- 8. Empathy
- 9. Coping with Emotions
- 10. Coping with Stress.
- The session was more informative and gained more knowledge about Life skill education.
- In this session, there was more interaction with all the participants.
- Before concluding the session, he called freely to be opened up to ask and clarify the doubts to Resource person. The participants were eager to ask and clarify the questions and doubts.

After the second session, there was break for 10min to start the 3rd session.

SESSION - III

"MYTHS AND MISCONCEPTION OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE"

The third session was started at 12:30pm and this session was handled by Mr. Amit Kumar.

- The third session topic was "Myths and Misconception of Substance abuse".
- ➤ He started his session by asking question "what is myth according to students?".
- ➤ He shared various slide by showing the Questions of "Myths and Facts". For instance.
